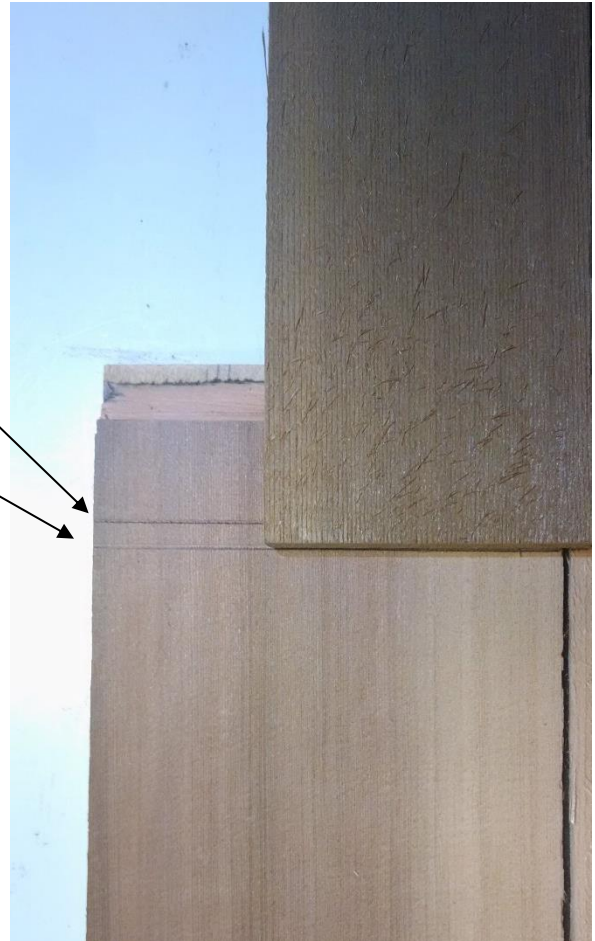
The New "Dual Scribe Nailing Line" Evenbutt panels simplify installation

## NEW-Dual Scribe Nail Placement Line

While the lower scribe line is still used for course alignment, the **new upper scribe line** is for nail placement on our Evenbutt panels. When installers drive the fasteners on or near the upper line, they are sure to get the highest wind uplift resistance while still concealing the nail head with the next row of panels. With the correct fastener and nailing into studs, a hurricane rating is achieved on all Cedar Valley panels! (see actual Nailing Instructions)

## Same installation, Easier Nailing

With the new Dual Scribe Line panels, installation just became simpler than ever! The panels have the same, installation and we have added a second scribe line for nail placement. This allows workers with pneumatic nailers a visible mark to drive the nails. And when the next row is installed everything will be concealed.

NOTE: Cedar Valley panels with the Dual Scribe Nailing line will also work with our original Evenbutt panels and corners.
